

University of North Dakota Volleyball 2017 Summer Camp Rules

- Any form of discrimination including harassment is prohibited. Harassment or unwelcome behavior of any nature will not be tolerated. This includes but is not limited to bullying, cyber-bullying, sexual harassment/violence and hazing.
- The use of alcohol and other illegal substances is prohibited. Campers may not possess, use, distribute, or sell alcoholic beverages, drugs, firearms, weapons or fireworks.(Campus Regulation)
- UND is a tobacco free campus. No camper should be in possession of smoking or chewing tobacco. (Campus Regulation)
- If you wish to be released from camp prior to end of camp or for a limited amount of time during camp, you must inform camp personnel so that an Early Release Form can be filled out and provided to housing staff.
- If you are staying in the dorms, and you leave the dorm without permission from a UND Volleyball Camp Counselor, your parents will be called to pick you up, and you will be dismissed from camp, and no refund will be given.
- When walking to a meal, stay with your camp counselor. No camper should be alone walking to and from the dorms, the gyms, or the cafeteria.
- You must stay in the Betty Englestad Sioux Center, or the UND Campus Recreation Center from the beginning of the session until the end of the session, or until you have been released to your parents/legal guardian.
- Listen to your camp counselors.
- Attempt every drill, even if you think you can't do it.
- Throw any of your trash (water bottles, paper, ankle tape, pre-wrap)
- Good sportsmanship is always encouraged. No foul language will be tolerated.
