

University of North Dakota Swimming Camp Rules

1. Campers are expected to conduct themselves as ladies and gentlemen at all times. Inappropriate language and/or behavior will not be tolerated.
2. Campers are to be respectful of University and camp staff as well as University and camp property.
3. UND swim camp prohibits the use of alcohol and other illegal substances. Campers may not possess, use, distribute, or sell alcoholic beverages, drugs, firearms, weapons or fireworks (campus regulation)
4. UND is a tobacco free campus. No camper should be in possession of smoking or chewing tobacco (campus regulation).
5. All medication for campers must be noted with the camp director.
6. Campers are not allowed in dorm rooms of the opposite gender.
7. Campers will adhere to lights out as described in the pre-camp meeting.
8. UND swim camp prohibits any form of discrimination including harassment. Harassment or unwelcome behavior of any nature will not be tolerated. This includes but is not limited to bullying, Cyber-bullying, sexual harassment/violence and hazing.
9. Campers are expected to attend all camp sessions and be on time for warm up. Campers must walk to and from the pool, dorms, and dining hall with their group and their group coaches. Campers are NEVER permitted to leave the pool, dorms, or dining hall without a coach or a counselor.
